## Westfield Neighbourhood Plan Information Statement

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A referendum in relation to the adoption of Westfield Neighbourhood Plan will be held on Thursday 6 September 2018.

The question which will be asked in the referendum is:

**‘Do you want Bath & North East Somerset Council to use the neighbourhood plan for Westfield to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?’**

The referendum area is identical to the area which has been designated as the Westfield Neighbourhood Plan Area.

A person is entitled to vote in the referendum if:

- he or she is entitled to vote in a local government election in the referendum area, and
- his or her qualifying address<sup>1</sup> for the election is in the referendum area

The referendum expenses limit is £2,644. The number of persons entitled to vote in the referendum by reference to which that limit has been calculated is 4,785.

The referendum will be conducted in accordance with procedures which are similar to those used at local government elections.
