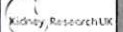

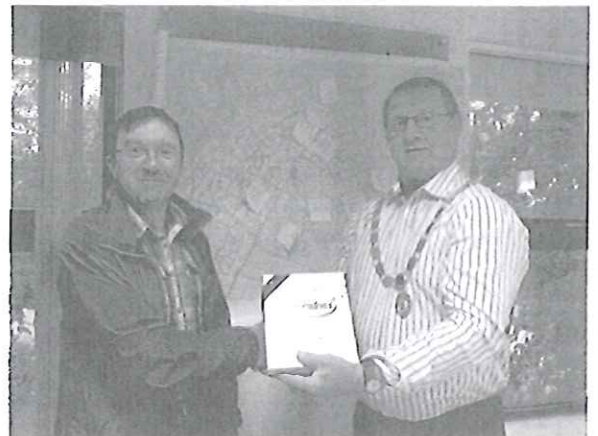

A large map of Westfield, also used at the Neighbourhood Plan consultation events, was dotted with feedback notes giving views and suggestions on development, green spaces and amenities. At the same time, visitors to the stand were invited to take a chance on the Treasure Hunt by placing a marker somewhere within the parish. The treasure spot was drawn out of a hat and Mr Jon Plenty was the proud winner of the prize, which he accepted with thanks at a meeting of the Parish Council.

Westfield's Neighbourhood Plan is now moving into its second year. Having consulted the parish at a number of open events, the working group is now considering the findings of the consultation in relation to the next steps in drawing up the options, which will go back out to consultation.
