## Consultation on the square of green space at the back of Larch Court

Several months ago the Parish Council was asked to try to find out who is responsible for maintaining the green space at the back of Larch Court shown highlighted in red on the map overleaf. After some investigation it was found that this land still belongs to Taylor Wimpey and they have suggested that Bath and North East Somerset Council should adopt it and maintain it. At the same time there was a suggestion that ball games were causing a nuisance and that it might be put to better use as a small allotment site.
