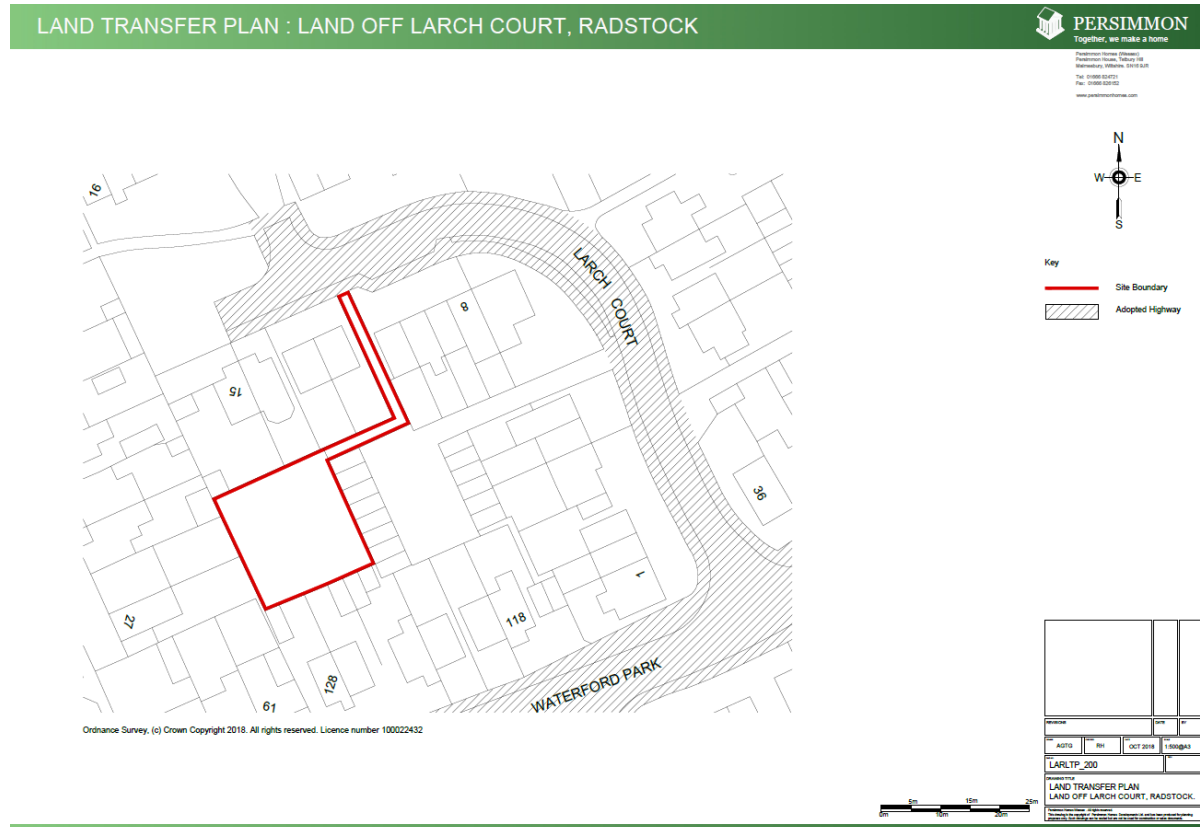
Update on the square of green space at the back of Larch Court

We wrote to you in May last year following the September 2017 consultation on the square piece of land at the back of Larch Court.

You may remember that as a result of the consultation the Parish Council contacted the landowner to have the land transferred for the purpose of a small allotment site, with just six plots, all of which in the first instance were to be offered to residents surrounding the site. Any which remained untaken would be offered to those on the allotments waiting list.

Reducing the number of plots on site was a measure the Parish Council took to address concerns which arose during consultation that parking may be a difficulty. In addition the decision to offer plots in the first instance to residents living adjacent to the site was also highlighted as a way to reduce parking.

We are writing to let you know that the Parish Council's application for s.106 funding to create the allotment site was successful and the transfer of the land has recently taken place, as detailed on the plan below.



Over the coming weeks you will therefore see works begin and the allotments take shape.

The site will be managed by the Westfield Allotment and Garden Society (WAGS), who look after the lovely site on Waterford Park. More information can be found at <http://www.westfieldparishcouncil.co.uk/allotments/>
