Consultation on the disused land adjacent to 16 Linden Close

You will be aware of the disused piece of land, in private ownership, bordered with metal barriers, adjacent to 16 Linden Close.

To help tidy up the area, the Parish Council is looking into the possibility of purchasing the land to create a small allotment site. This will be in walking distance of the larger allotment site on Waterford Park managed by the Westfield Allotment and Garden Society (WAGS). If it went ahead, WAGS would also manage the site at Linden Close.

We are conscious that this area is very much an eyesore, a potential health and safety hazard, and could get colonised by foxes or badgers, creating more problems. We would dearly like to have it tidied up and used as allotments. Before we move ahead in any way, we would like your views as local residents.
