## 131. Recreation Ground - Norton Hill

It was noted that a date was set to remove the Ash trees at Norton Hill Recreation Ground – early May.

**Resolved:** to bring back on the next Committee agenda the question of whether to re-plant on the bank adjacent to the A367 and, if so, whether trees are appropriate at that location, or smaller plants. It could be that some specialist advice will be needed.

It was noted that the handle had been broken off the door at the home team entrance to the pavilion, but had been replaced.

The Legionella survey had been done the day of the meeting, so no report was available as yet.

## 132. Recreation Ground - Westhill

**Changing Rooms** – It was noted that the boundary agreement had been signed by both parties and sent to Land Registry. The average response time from the Land Registry is 6 months.

It was felt that the grass management report from FWAG SouthWest showed that funding was available from the Countryside Management Stewardship to cover future costs.

*Management of the overgrown hedge:* Options were offered for the maintenance of the overgrown hedge.

I have currently agreed to amend the work specification to this case as the applicant hasn't really been given good advice

I will amend the spec to being

Ash x 2 - Pollard both trees to 3m in height (both are infected with Ash Die Back and one is tight adjacent a neighbours property) - in light of the ADB I am happy that this is reasonable

Sycamore - Crown reduce by 3m (not 10m)

Leylandii - no works agreed at this time as waiting to get an arborist to inspect them for him

There is a leaning tree (drawn up) between the leylandii however that he'd like to remove.

I will clarify this on the planning case as plan to visit to see it for myself (and yes your response is fine for 12/03 - I'll have clarified the latter point by then)

I have been passed your email from George Blanchard.

The current local plan consultation is an options consultation where we are exploring all options for development, no sites will be allocated until the draft plan stage.

Within the Somer Valley chapter a number of non-strategic and potential small sites have been proposed. This includes the land within Westfield, WF1. The map included in the options document does not yet include a site outline as this would be refined at the draft plan stage if the site was to be allocated.

It would be good to have the views of the parish council on this. For example if you think this is a good site for development or where you think development should be located.


